(1) On the Problem of Love Affairs (Answer to some old people)

1. The Confucius said: "Eating & Drinking and love affair are unavoidable". So the problem of love affair is the same in all periods and in all countries. But the difference is:

2. In the civilized countries grown-up boys and girls make acquaintance with each other and then love each other. It is the freedom of love. After that they get married. It is the freedom of marriage. Parents never force their children in this field. So the couple is happy all their family life.

3. In our country when the young get married, parents seldom ask the children whether they agree or not. Even they forces their children to marry the ones who are liked by the parents.

So there are always conflicts in the newly wed couples, and they get divorced or commit suicide. It is a bad custom. Parents should not force children in love!

4. And what is the revolution? The revolution is organization unity aimed at fighting France, Japan so that our people do not have to do forced labour, join army, pay taxes.

It makes every body happy. So every body should join, especially the young.

5. With a common goal, a common organization, let's consider each other brothers and sisters of the same family. When any young man falls in love with any young woman, they should report it to the organization, ask for permission from their parents, and publicly hold wedding ceremony.
