* Some free months

- . All the year, everyone is busy with farming, thus spending little time for learning and revolutionary activities.
- . In July and August when having completed the tilling, we are all free. We should spend these two months for learning and revolutionary activities.
- . In order to do so, just now now the provincial and district committees must work out the programme of activities in advance, and must explain everything for the cadres of the cantons and villages. The programme will be carried out when we have free time. If only by then, we start to work out the programme of activities, it will be too late.
- . The programme must be conformable to the concrete situation. Therefore, when working out the programme, we must consider the local situation. However, in principle, the programme must be aimed at development and consolidation, and it must consist of three tasks, namely to propagandize, to organize and to train.

• The provincial and district committees must do like this:

- If the region has no organization, some cadres should be sent there to propagandise and establish revolutionary organizations.

- If the region hasn't yet some organizations (such as the women's union, the children's union...), they must be established.

- Cadres must be sent to different regions to train people (in terms of politics, self-defence, national language).

• If village A has been organized and village B hasn't been organized yet, village A must take charge of organizing village B.

- The cadres also take charge of two tasks more: investigating the local situation, and mobilizing more readers and more contributors.

• The work, the time, the place and the person in charge must be defined in the programme. The provincial and district committees must send cadres to different regions frequently to investigate the concrete situation. And the cadres must report the situations to the committees.

• Different districts, different villages, cadres, and members of the Unions must compete with each other in revolutionary activities, the winners will have their names mentioned in the paper.
