① Two anti-terror vanguard groups worth commending.

In the last two months of June and July, the mountain district LS was terrorized! Throughout the district the organization members have been trying to oppose the policy of arrest of France and Japas. In H. canton in particular the local cadres had an initiative to summon the most resolute members to form 2 anti-terror vanguard groups. Their task is to explain to members and convince them not to fear terror.

The vanguard members volunteer to do the following:

- ① to be calm, careful and secret.
- ② try to explain to members not to be afraid of hardships, dangers;
- ③ try to accomplish the group's plan.

This was the first time the inhabitants of LS was terrorized so the members who appear to be panic-stricken and dismayed are by no means few. In that situation, the mandarins and village notables have become more aggressive. They threatened the people for money, forced them to keep guard, sent soldiers to villages to search for revolutionaries. So the cause to fight terror was by no means easy. Even so, the vanguard members were deeply convinced that if they comply strictly with the directives to fight terror which have been made elaborated by the provincial party and carried in the newspaper V.N. D.L, they will certainly succeed. Therefore they try to explain to members. The result ~~this~~ is that at present the associations in our regions are not disintegrated, but have developed more strongly than ever before. All members managed to keep calm, to be determined and keep secret better than before.

Experiences of the two vanguard groups can be summed up as follows: ① in face of the terror, the immediate task is to explain to members the terror; ② patience is needed in explaining terror. Carefulness, boldness are also necessary

③ Domestic News. - On Sep. 25, Gia Lai was bombed again. Nearly 100 Vietnamese were killed and injured. Japanese also died in great numbers but they did not disclose the exact figure.

At the same time in Lao Cai, the Chinese planes were flying in low altitude and fired by machine guns at the streets where the Japanese soldiers were stationed. Some of our people were also killed by the shelling.

In Nguyen Binh France under Japan's order, forced each village to hand in some thousands of kg of rice to them. In the previous years, the harvests were good, so the people had enough food. This year, because of the drought, a lot of rice was damaged and looted by France and Japan. What should our people eat?
