When they took a glance at the newspaper and then threw it away, they did not think of how many hardships the newspaper men experienced to make and publish it. Everybody knows how expensive the paper is now. And a bottle of ink which is as big as a tin of condensed milk cost 2 \$00, is now selling 25 \$00, and it must be bought from abroad. It takes time. Sometimes it never comes. Furthermore, other materials are very expensive and very difficult to buy. When there are enough materials, some people are needed to write. It is very costly to do these things. If we make a careful calculation, the cost of each issue is much higher than the price at which it is sold to

members.

Therefore, we suggest that cadres and members should know how to use the newspaper to its full value.
