2) Artillery fired at Lũng Hoang (near Núoc Hai, Hòa An)

On Dec. 13 lunar calendar or Feb. 26, 1945, the French fascists launched a big attack on Lũng Hoang, where they said was the revolutionary headquarter.

At 6 a.m., nearly 10 artillery shells were fired at Lũng Hoang. Immediately after that, their regular forces totalling about 100 men moved towards Lũng Hoang. At the same time they dispatched units of about 20 or 30 men to ambush on all the roads leading to Lũng Hoang. The total number of the attackers amounted to 200 men comprising all sharpshooters and artillery men.

The fascist regular forces, when moving into Lũng Hoang, only met with trees and stones. Nothing happened at the places of ambush. Only the unit that moved along from the Lũng Hoang pass to Lũng Viết confronted with danger.

At 10, this group of about 20 soldiers met a guarding post of the revolutionaries from which some gunshots were fired and forced the group to retreat. 3 hours after, they came back with enforcement of men and machine guns. They fired heavily at the guarding post, from which ^{gunnings} there were heard: "The Vietnamese should not fire at the Vietnamese!" The soldiers went on moving forwards. Suddenly a grenade was dropped and exploded loudly. The soldiers at once became quiet and vanished a short time after.

Having failed the second time, the fascists sent their men to Núoc Hai to transmit a message asking for enforcement from Cao Bằng. More than one hour after,

machine guns were heavily and continuously fired at the guarding post. Half an hour after, hearing no sounds from the post, they entered it and captured two ragged posts and retreated.

At 5 p.m all soldiers withdrew from Muôe Hai with 5 wounded.

When the evening was approaching, a soldier went into the village. The villagers asked: "How was the fighting with the revolutionaries today?"

The soldier answered: "The revolutionaries won!"

The soldier had summed up the "great" offensive at Lũng Hoang quite correctly.

While the Allied countries - including the Democratic France - were ejecting the German and Japanese fascists from Europe to Asia, the fascists in Cao Bằng used artillery to shell Lũng Hoang.

Was it a response by the French fascists to the appeal calling for solidarity to fight Japan by Viet Minh?

Anyway the "great" offensive at Lũng Hoang was a defeat to the fascists.

In order to remember this event, and also to congratulate the heroic soldiers and all our soldiers, the newspaper presents this poem:

- Lũng Hoang mountain, Se-lac stream,

Hare prescribed for ever the heroism of Viet Minh

Even is the roar of artillery

They fascists were shocked twice

So the soldiers, whatever remote or close

Should follow their struggling spirit!

For full independence of Vietnam

for our valuable homeland which will exist forever.

4) A Notice by the Propaganda Unit of V.L.A.

In the evening of Dec. 15 lunar calendar, or Feb. 28, 1940, the P.U carried out an armed propaganda which was very influencing in the street of Quang-Uyên.

In that evening, at 9 the P.U despatched a number of groups including some women to spread leaflets, slogans, and attach the red flag with golden star on all the roads to Cao Bằng, Trung Khanh, Tà Lùng. After that, the members set fire on a newly-built Army camp. At the same time a number of gunshots were fired at the station. From the station, the sounds of trumpet were heard, but not clearly.

The purpose of the P.U was to call on the soldiers and people of Quang-Uyên to stand up with the Viet Minh members everywhere to fight the enemy for national salvation.

The day of 16 was the opening day of the Quang-Uyên market. On that day the soldiers in Quang-Uyên and many other people only discussed and pranced the P.U.

And the fascists were trying to search them, but to no avail.
