Demonstrations and marches against the Japanese

On March 3, 1945, over 500 compatriots of all circles in T.D. district, Ngo gia Tu province staged demonstrations in daylight through villages with dreums beating and appealing on the population with speeches. The demonstrators waved Viet Minh flags, carrying banners with slogans such as :"To expel the Japanese" "To protest against the pro-Japanese puopet Vietnamese government" " Long live the revolutionary people's power "...

Demolishing the Japanese paddy stores

Right after the Japanese overthrew the French, the movement for demolis -hing the Japanese paddy stores to distribute it to poor people has spread to all the provinces.

On March 15, 1945, thousands of people in Th.Th.district, Ngo gia Tu province came to demolish the French paddy store in the pagoda of Dau village. The demonstrators spoke about the Japanese overthrowing the Frenchxm and elected a committee in charge of the paddy distribution.

On March 13, 1945, neary 1.000 people in H.H. district, De Tham province staged a demonstration, came to the Co post and confiscated paddy and rice and seize a quantity of ammunitions.

On the same day, over 3.000 people in H.H. district, De Tham province staged a demonstration, came to the Vat post, confiscated some paddy, rice and guns. Angry with he tred against the Frech colonialits, they have destroyed a big house of the plantations owner.

On March 12, 1945, over 200 peasants came to the Tru cu post, tried to seize paddy, but 4 persons were shot dead by the soldiers. The demonstrators mustdisperse. Two days later, over 2.000 people came again to the Tri cu post. This time, they confiscated all the paddy, guns, ammunitions and medicies. All the political prisoners and common-law prisoners have been liberated by the population.

Revolt at Nghia Lo camp

Over 100 detainees in Nghĩa Lo (Yen Bai province), making use of the fighting between the Japanese and the French, rose up. Some tens of them have been killed in the combat. Most of them have escaped.

Arresting the district chief

On March 13, 1945, 30 young men of the V.D. region, De Tham province armeds with guns, sushed in the district office, a rrested the district chief and brought him to a nearby village, beated drums to gether the po-

Bafore the population, the young men cited the crimes committed by the district chief, gave him a severe warning then released him.

Guerilla combat

Right after the Japanese overthrew the French, the Viet Minh guerilleroes also opened fire against the Japanese. They attacked against many posts, occupied some or withrew according to the situation.

The guerilla movement is strong in the majountainous and middle-regions of Tonkin. Some violent comba t have ca used many damages to the Japane - se. The road Nam quan has been cut by our forces. Tens of trucks carrying wounded Japanese soldires to Hanoi.

The guarillera warfare spread rapidly in Lang son, Thai nguyen. The Bac Son, MxxxxxX Vu nhai, Dai tu, Dinh hoq fell into the hands of the revolutionary troop s.

On April 8, 1945 the Japanese came to the Dai tu, Son Duong districts made arrestation among the population, on their way, they were intercepted and must "withdraw.One Japanese officer and 2 horses were killed 3 soldiers and 2 asses were wounded.

After the coup d'Etat, a ceftain number of French soldiers ran away to the Luong Son district (Hoa binh province) and together with the population fought a gainst the Japanese. The latter came to repression. But the guerilla movement spread to Lac Son district.

In central Vietnam, guerilla warfare is active in Nha trang; in Nam ky querilleroes are active again in Hau giang.

THE JAPANESE ARE IN A DESASTROUS SITUATION

- 1) Che war in Europe is over. Now *** Great Britain and the U.S. are *** free to deal only with the short Japanese. At present, theyon one hand are transfering troops and armaments from Europe to Asia, on the other hand they are helping China to build its forces; when these preparations are finished, Japan cannot survive the coming general counter-offensive.
