In Vietnam and the Indonesian archipelago, the flames of the resistance war against the imperialist aggressors have burst off and are spreading and may lead the humanity to an 3th world war if the Allies countrues do not realise the "self determination" principle in this region. ## NEWS FROM INDOCHINA

The Chinese troops have entered Viantiane (capital of Laos). The Chinese and Vietnamese residents there have warmly welcomed the Chinese troops.

General Ha Ung Kham, commander-in-chiefof Chinase army has arrived in Hanoi. Hundreds of hanoians have welcomed their arrival, waving U.S., Chinese and Vietnamese flage

3.000 British and Indian troops, together with some xmmsten thousand French residents in Saigon are causing troubles ∉against the independence of of Vietnam. The revolutionary forces nymber about 7.000 who, together with millions of people armed with whatever arms, launch a strong attack against the aggressors. There are 4.000 Japanese soldiers in Saigon and 70.000 Japanese soldiers around Saigon who help the aggressors. But the Vietnamese people are resolute to make any sacrifices in order to defend their independence

Our armed forces have obtained many successes: dest**pg**ying many enemy food stores, seized 4 trucks suppying the French with/armements. One guerilla man has succeeding in killing up to 150 enemy soldiers.
